


- ◆ Encourage my child to take responsibility for their own learning.
- ◆ Supply the school with the necessary details to enable them to deal with any emergencies/accidents that might occur during school opening hours.
- ◆ Respect all school property and be responsible for any books or equipment loaned to us by the school.
- ◆ Encourage my child to keep the school environment clean and tidy with particular regard to graffiti and litter.
- ◆ Respond quickly and positively to request of support from school in relation to the development of my child's educational needs.
- ◆ Reinforce the importance of tolerance and respect towards others at all times.
- ◆ Ensure that my child wears the correct school uniform with pride and does nothing to undermine the good name of the school inside and outside the school environment.
- ◆ **Ensure that my child understands that physical violence towards another pupil may result in a suspension.**
- ◆ Support the school's e-safety and cyber-bullying policy by monitoring your child's use of social networks and electronic communication.
