Dear Parent/Carer,

It is the time of year when I like to send out a Christmas message to all our families to thank you for your support throughout the autumn term and wish you all well. I have been the Acting Headteacher of the Heys School for the past 4 weeks and I have enjoyed getting to know all the students and staff. It was wonderful to attend the recent school productions and meet some of the parents of the cast.

We are very proud of how students have settled with the changes to staffing in the school since September and we look forward to welcoming two new Science teachers, one after Christmas and one in February, and a new Maths teacher in the new year. This will provide even more consistency for our students.

There have been challenges regarding a small minority of students who have had to work a little harder to engage with the high expectations we have at The Heys School, but we are pleased with the progress they have made.
