Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you of an important update to our behaviour and detention system, designed to strengthen consistency, improve communication, and ensure that every student receives a fresh start each day.

From September, we will be moving to a same-day centralised detention system. This means that if a student receives a detention, it will take place on the same day and will last for 30 minutes.

Parents and carers will be notified by email on the day the detention is issued.

It is essential that the school holds accurate and up-to-date contact information. Email will be our primary method of communication regarding same-day detentions, so please ensure your details are current to avoid missing important updates.

If a student does not attend their same-day detention, the consequence will escalate to a one-hour detention the following day. Failure to attend the one-hour detention will result in a full day in our Reflection Room, followed by completion of the outstanding one-hour detention.

This change allows us to address behaviour promptly, discuss incidents while they are still fresh, and support students in resetting positively for the following day. Our aim is to ensure that both staff and students benefit from a clear, consistent system that reinforces expectations while prioritising restorative conversations and providing a fresh start.

Thank you for your continued support as we work together to maintain a calm, respectful, and purposeful environment for all our students.
